From November 18th to December 23rd, 2023, Anne Horel presents her creations at Julie Caredda Gallery during her exhibition titled "Créatures." Through her surreal universe, she plays with the dematerialization of the art object while acknowledging the digital's current primacy.

Anne Horel redefines contemporary art in the age of creative technologies. Since 2008, she has embraced social media as a full-fledged medium of creation, producing video clips and short films. Inspired by the vibrancy of social networks and new media, Anne Horel understood that the aesthetics of the future would emerge on the internet and in the era of late capitalism. Her experiences have led her to contemplate memory and the traces we leave in the digital age.

The immersive exhibition's scenography reflects the accumulation present in her work. One wall is covered with wallpaper depicting food and creatures, evoking a multicultural fast-food world. At the back of the gallery, a cabinet of curiosities is brimming with gadgets and diverse objects, mirroring the accumulation of objects and images in her art.

Anne Horel's creations give life to "creatures," hybrids of the human and the digital, embodying the essence of our time. They are like "cable-connected" entities, linked to terrestrial life by invisible threads. By animating these creatures, she breathes life into them and brings them out of the screen, thus questioning our connection with the digital world.

Her works are altars of memory, honoring the abundance of our era. Drawing inspiration from mythology, cartomancy, and spirituality, she creates monsters and demigods that capture the signs and traces of our time. These "datadeities" are remnants of our digital lives, carrying our beliefs and fantasies.

The exhibition immerses the visitor in a journey through Anne Horel's universe, a blend of overloaded kitsch and contemporary truth. It is an exploration of future memories through accumulation, creation, and digital art.
